AED Defibrillator and Naloxone kit Locations

There are 2 AED Defibrillators and 1 Naloxone kit located in the Biological Sciences Building. 1. West Wing: AED & Naloxone kit outside Lecture room 2200 (near fountain entrance) 2. East Wing: AED in Student Area 3020 (outside M&I's lab room 3125)

There is 1 AED Defibrillator located in the Biodiversity Research Center. 1. Main lobby, next to front entrance (across from room 113)

Chemical spill cart Locations

There are 4 chemical spill carts located in the Biological Sciences Building.

- 1. Teaching Labs (Botany/Zoology): East Wing alcove 2014 next to the ice machine
- 2. Botany Growth Chamber: South Wing Room 2374
- 3. Botany Research: South Wing Freezer Room 2303
- 4. Zoology Research: 4th floor South wing in front of East wing entrance inside wooden cabinet

There is 1 chemical spill cart located in the **Biodiversity Research Center**.

1. Next to the window at the top of the central stairwell, 2nd floor landing across of meeting room 224

Although each lab is supposed to have their own chemical spill kit designed specifically for the chemicals they have in their lab, these spill kits are an emergency secondary backup.

How to deal with spills and accidental releases?

All spills and accidental releases must be reported in the UBC Centralized Accident Incident Reporting System (CAIRS).

Call 911 if chemical spills are larger than 1 litre or you are not comfortable to clean it up spills less than 1 litre. Vancouver Fire and Rescue Services will notify the Hazmat Team.
