They descended again, and swam towards the site however before reaching the site they surfaced again, while talking at the surface they drifted again. Current picked up more, students swam at the surface towards the site, when they descended they got lost once more, as the tide was rising the object started drifting, when they surfaced they continue to drift. I directed them to exit the water. Loss of awareness. I was not able to enter the water as I was the surface safety supervisor for this dive.
